WEDNESDAY NITE RIDES. . . Meet at the McClure Library every Wednesday night at 7:00 p. m. (weather permitting) for a pleasant evening ride to Sheridan Village and back. We take little-traveled side streets to avoid traffic.

SUNDAY MORNING, May 30, 9:00 a. m. Meet at Lakeview Center and cycle west on Big Hollow Road to Koerner Road and the new Peoria Youth Hostel. Take along a sandwich and something to drink if you wish; there are picnic tables at the hostel. This is an easy ride with just one hill.

SUNDAY MORNING, June 6, 9:00 a. m. Meet in downtown Peoria at Courthouse Square (near the fountain) and cycle to Marton.

SUNDAY MORNING, June 13, 9:00 a. m. Meet at Mossville Grade School (near the Caterpillar Industrial Engine Plant at Mossville) and cycle through Chillicothe and Rome. This ride is about 18 miles long and is on secondary roads with little traffic.

We welcome suggestions about rides -- let us know where and when you want to ride. We prefer to ride at times when there is little traffic-- on less-traveled roads. Each member rides at his own risk (the club assumes no responsibility for accidents) and we hope to keep cycling a safe as well as a healthy sport.

The New Salem/Springfield ride was highly successful, with about 20 Peorians participating. The ride was gruelling and the finish muddy, but the first day and a half (including the cookout) was terrific! Our heartfelt thanks to Sue Garmer for carrying through this ambitious project conceived by her husband.

A statewide rally will be held in Springfield on Saturday, June 26 in support of the Illinois Bikeway Act. A number of students -- particularly from the U of I -- are expected to attend, and support from the general public is invited.

There is a possibility of a joint ride this fall with the Bloomington Roundabouts through Parke County (Rosedale) Indiana over the covered bridge trail.
