

This is the 50 miler! After a full summer's riding most of you should be good enough shape to make an easy 50 miles. This will be a leisurely ride beginning at Jubilee Park and riding to Princeville, Toulon, and back. The ride will be along rolling country roads so traffic shouldn't be a problem--but plan on spending most of the day 'on the road.' You can bring your lunch, but we will stop at a restaurant in town if you don't want to bother.

Children are welcome, but if under 16 they should be accompanied by an adult. Have your bike in top shape before the ride so you don't have to make any repairs or adjustments before the ride begins. Of course there will be unavoidable troubles so a 'sag wagon' will accompany us to assist with repairs and to pick up riders without enough steam to finish the entire ride.
