

1. A day and time during the week must be set that is best for most everyone.

3. An idea has been suggested to request entrance Fees (104-25¢) per race from each individual for end of the year trophies and prizes.

4. We need good race courses nearby (1/4-4 miles in

length).

5. Help is desperately needed in running the races

Keeping times, counting laps, and placing finishers.
6. Participants of all ages are wanted as we will keep records according to the different classes. Last year avg. speeds varied as much as 15-22 m.p.h.

7. New rules need to be looked at, such as:

c) general racing sportsmanship promoted Problems of transportation to and from the races need to be solved.
