RACING SECTION

The racing section will have its first club race this year on May 2. From then on, at least until the end of June, races will start at 6:30 P.M. at the designated areas in the schedule following. This year an extra effort will be made to start on time. Everyone must try to get to the races on time or before if he or she wants to warmup. Everyone will also have to arrange their own transportation. If anyone is able to take extra people and bikes, information given to me will be passed on to those expressing a need for a ride.

From a meeting held earlier in the spring, it was decided to charge \$.25 (that's just one quarter) per person per club race. The proceeds at the end of the year are to go for trophies and prizes divided up according to the ABL categories. Only club members scores will be kept and only club members will be allowed to race except for newcomers or visitors. For them two trail races will be allowed. Also all racers must bring or send in to secretary the release forms. Helmets will be required at all races.

We are still working on the Saturday morning race on an enclosed course at either Glen Oak or Bradley Park. Keep your mind on this one. Its one chance where we can make a strong showing and we will need all the racers participating. We'll keep you informed.

We are still looking for someone to run the racing section this year. In fact, I'll be leaving after the third race so someone is needed quickly. Also we would use several people helping at the races, and just as important participants.
