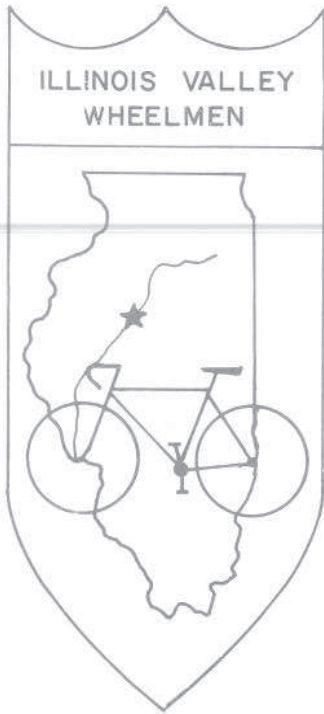


NEWS FLASH!

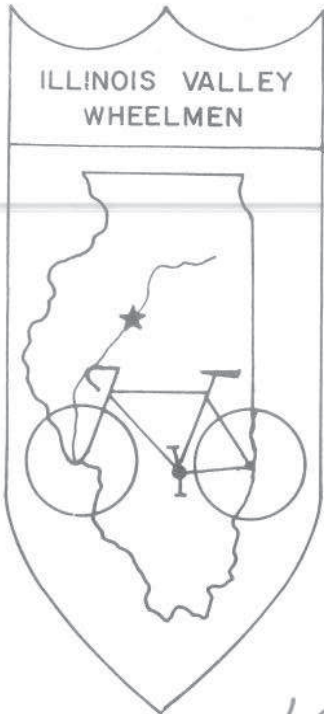
