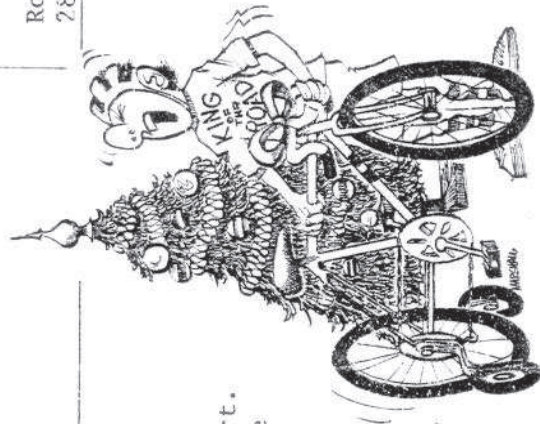

Due to a misprint in the application for racing membership that you may have received, it must be noted that IVW Racing Team dues are \$3.00, please excuse the error on the application.

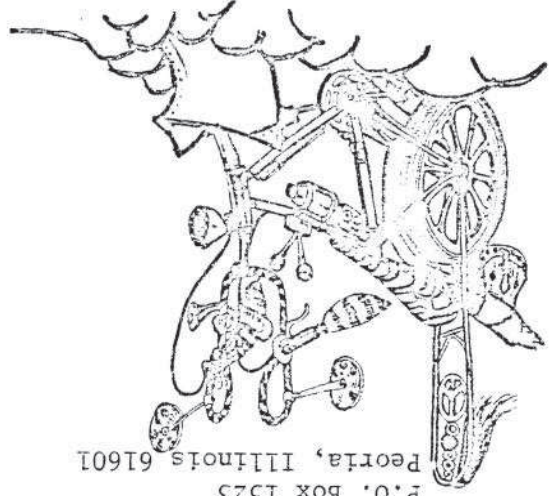
