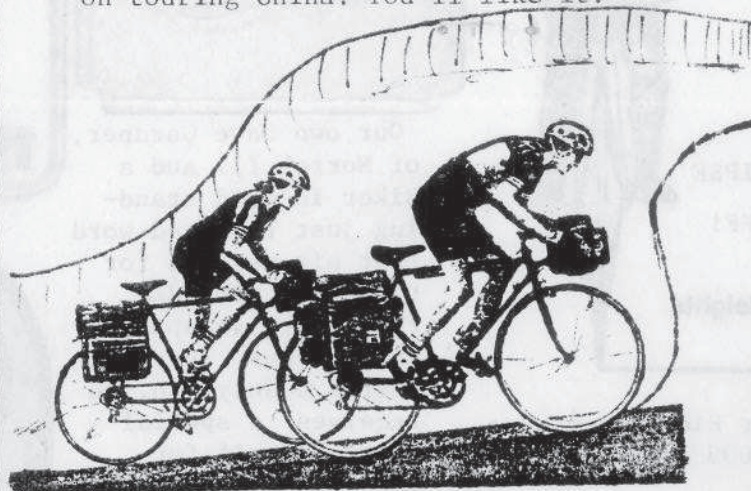

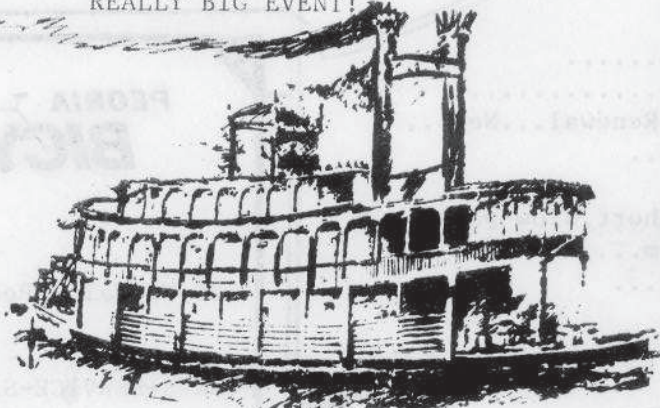

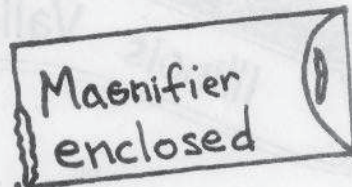
## SPECIAL EDITION OF THE 10th PEDAL IN

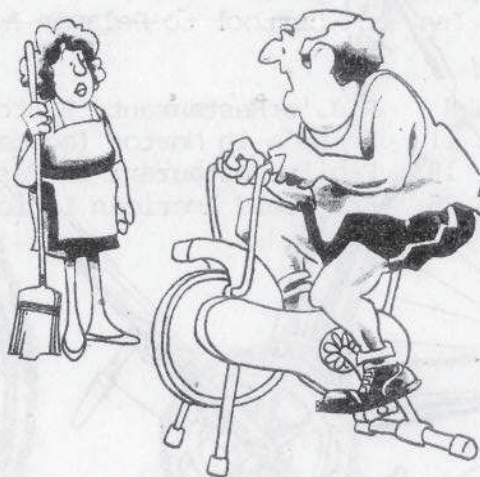

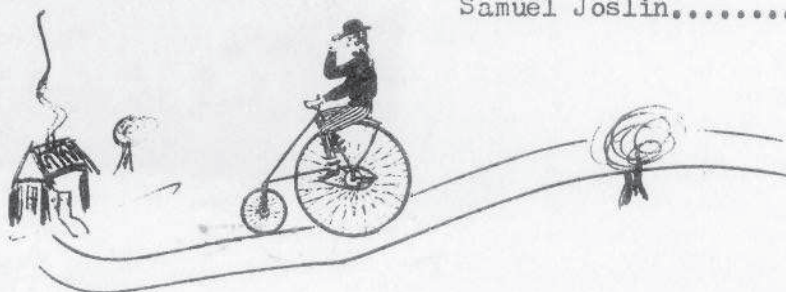

Lon Haldeman rode his the fastest. Diane Ziegler did one a couple years ago. Thomas Stevens was the FIRST. On April 22, 1984, Stevens left Oakland California to record the first transcontinental bike ride. His high-wheeler was pushed, shoved, & even at times ridden over 3000 miles & 103½ days. To celebrate the ride, Martin Potts of Washington, Il., along with several other antique bicycle enthusiasts, will mount his own high-wheeled bicycle & ride nearly the same route as the pioneer pedaler... except for the welcomed addition of paved roads. None of the later group has yet announced plans to further emulate Stevens by continuing to trace his journey around the world.

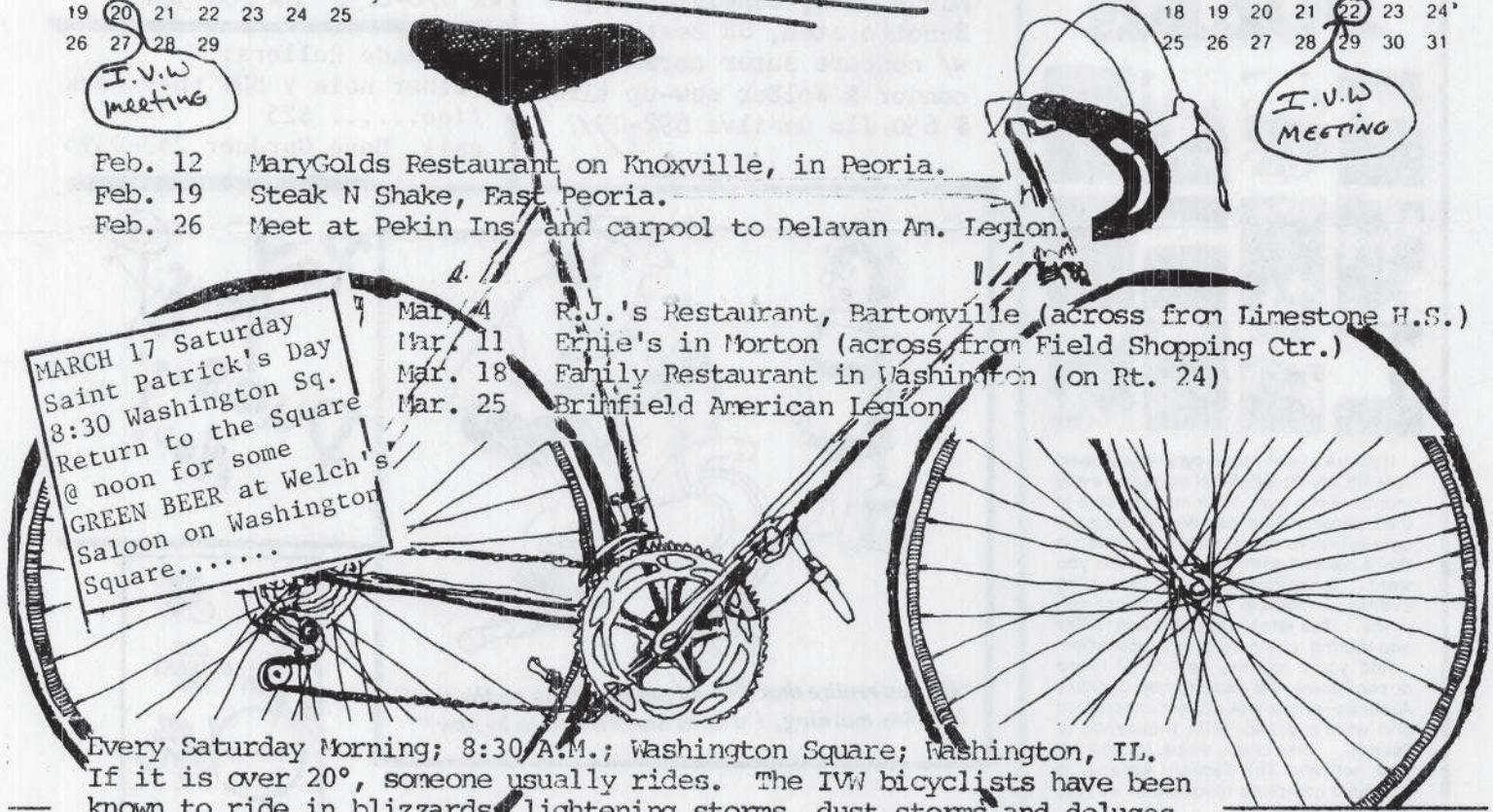
