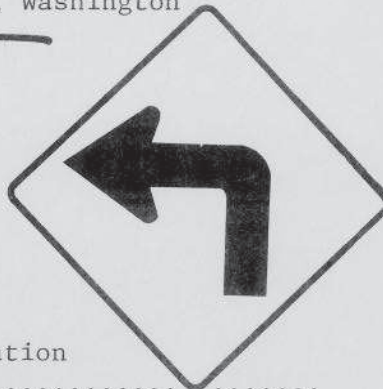

So you will receive a DOUBLE BARRELED show. See ya, there.....








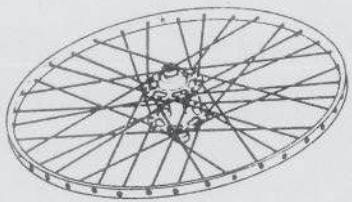
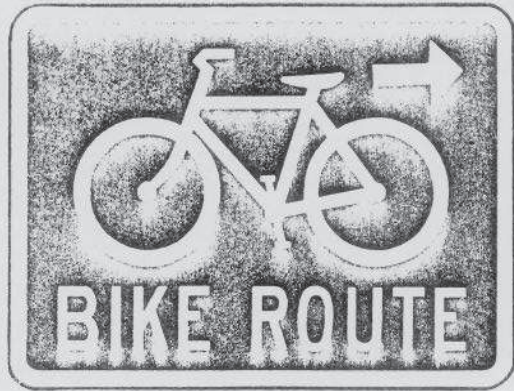

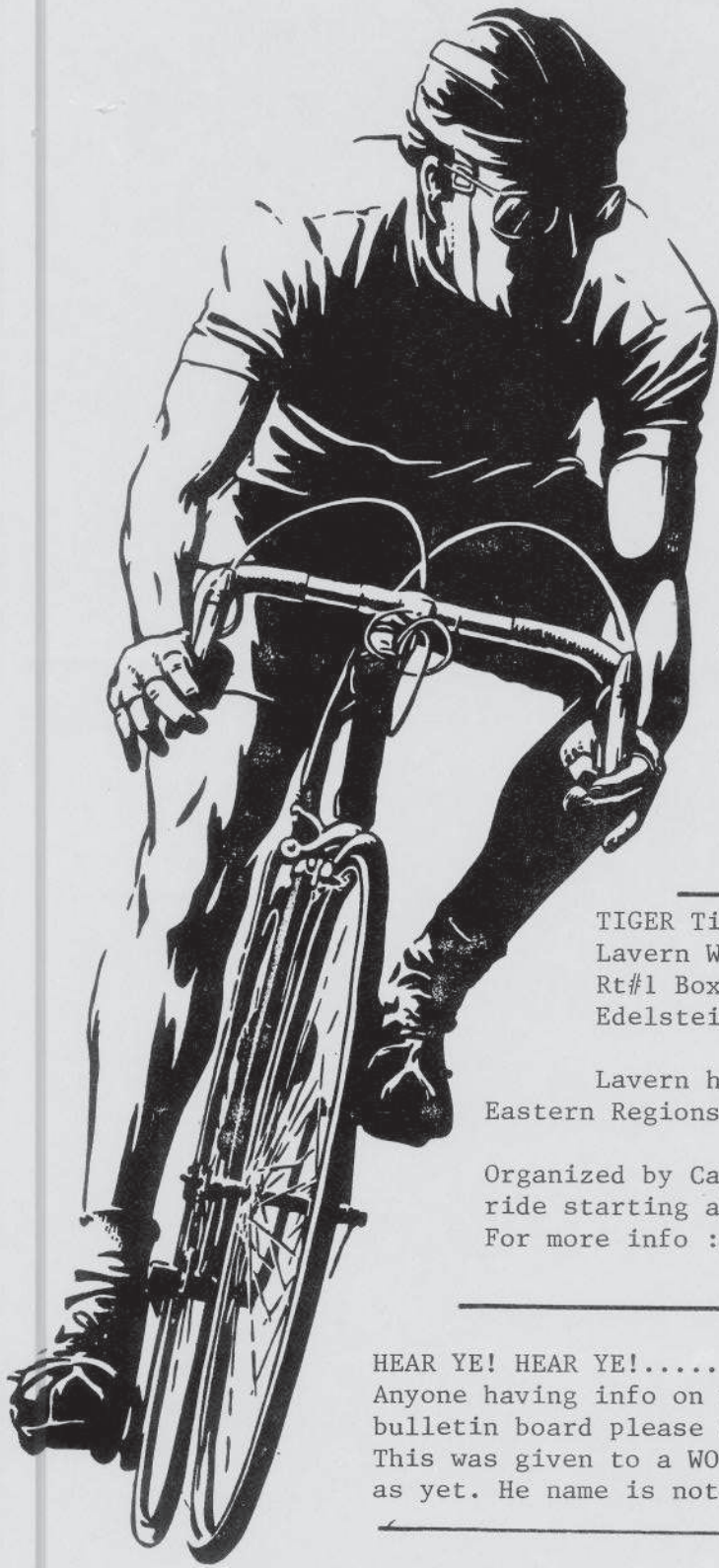
