


# FROM THE RIDE COMMITTEE "Leap Frog Ride II"

drive the car while you ride, and then switch off, while you drive-they ride, etc. As stated, it is a tailwind ride, which will make it a little warmer if the weather is cold. Bundle up and be prepared to ride in any kind of weather and road condition.


