The book <u>BICYCLE FEVER</u> written by Steven Streight has just been published by Ruppman Marketing Services, Inc. in Peoria. This book, complete with rare photos, paints an excellet picture of bicycling in the "Central City" during cycling's early heyday (1800's). In those days, Peoria was a nationally recognized bicycling center complete with 8 cycling clubs, 5 cycle manufacturers, and a 1/2 mile race track (complete with large grandstands) in Lakeview Park. 
