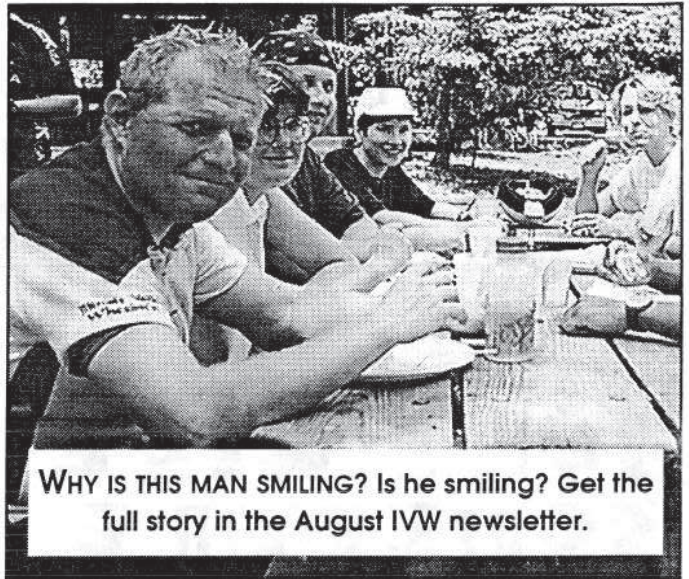
Club meeting

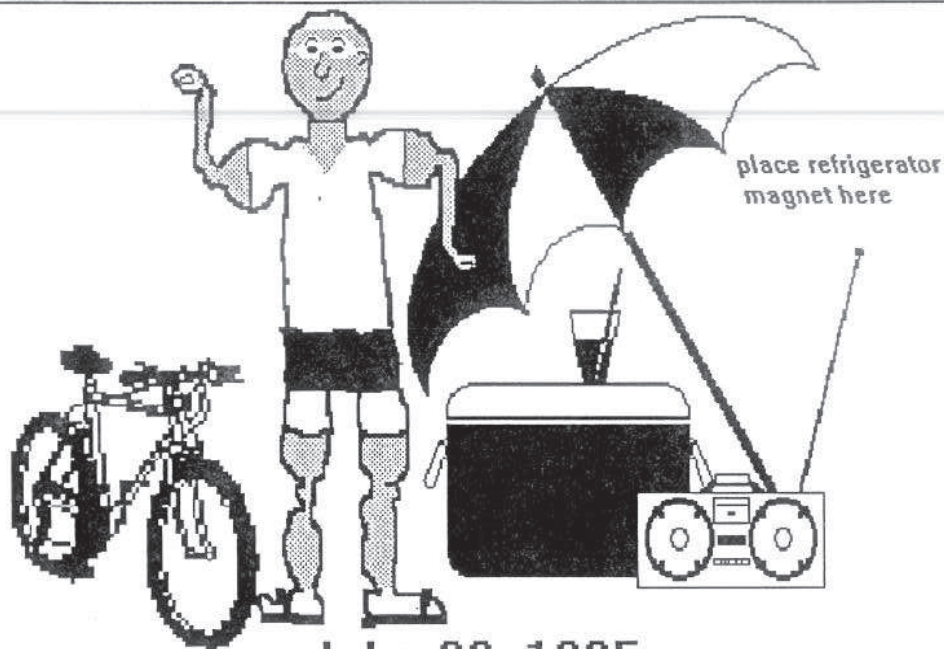
