Washington, DC — A new study suggests where you live could influence your risk of being killed by an aggressive driver. The livability of a community may play a key role in its aggressive driving death rate, according to a report released today by the Surface Transportation Policy Project (STPP) and presented to Transportation Secretary Rodney Slater at a White House event on traffic and road safety. The study suggests that the risk of dying in an aggressive driving crash is highest in places with few travel choices and uncontrolled sprawl, where the car is the only way to get things done. Places with lower aggressive driving death rates tend to be older, more walkable communities with more developed train and bus systems.
