



Three states: Illinois, Wisconsin and Michigan have agreed to design and purchase new trainsets that would be used to increase frequencies and reduce transit times for train service from Chicago to Madison, St. Louis and Detroit.

The design committee had their first meeting this week. I would like to improve our chances that they will include bike racks in the design. (I recently toured the trainset that they are leaning towards. It comes with very inexpensive, easy to use racks.)

Dear Governor,

Thank you for agreeing to cooperate with Wisconsin and Michigan on the design and purchase of modern trainsets for a midwest high speed rail network. Rail service is very important to the region and this is a very positive step forward. Please direct your staff to include bike racks in the design criteria of these trainsets. As you are aware, the use of bicycles for basic and recreational travel has increased dramatically recently. Bike racks onboard the train will increase rail ridership by creating an easy way to get to and from the station, and by extending the range of a bicycle trip. Thank you for your help in this matter.
