Shoulders to Lean On

Here's the problem: There's a beautiful lake in southern Illinois - Rend Lake - with a planned recreational trail to go around it. But how do you get to it? About the only access from the west is Illinois Route 154, a narrow, two-laned, no shoulder road which carries significant traffic, including boat trailers. When IDOT put the road up for improvement, LIB's road alert program jumped into action. With the help of local bicyclists, LIB called for significant roadway improvement. The result was a victory of sorts - a one-foot shoulder. We pointed out the Bicycle Accommodation standards that applied to the road, and in October District 9 let us know that after reevaluation of the shoulder width, it will be increased to four

Thanks to the IDOT for their design change, to the local cyclists who helped, and to LIB's state-wide road improvement alert program, Illinois cyclists will now enjoy a more bike-friendly road. 
