Hello IVW members! Before we know it, summer will be over and it will be time for our annual banquet and election of officers. Several of your current board members need a break and will be leaving office in November. Therefore, we've started the 2001 IVW Election Campaign! Please discuss board leadership with your fellow riders and consider who (maybe even you) would be good candidates for keeping this club rolling! Short descriptions of the various roles can be found below.

President: Coordinates and supervises the operation of the IVW board. Presides at all club meetings. Submits newsletter articles to newsletter editor and Web page editor as needed. Serves as liaison to other bike clubs, bike shops, and community organizations. Time requirement varies based upon desired level of involvement - typically about 6 hours per month.

Vice President: Attends all club meetings. Submits newsletter articles to newsletter editor. Must be willing to help the president or any other board member when necessary. Time requirement varies based upon desired level of involvement.

Membership/Social Chairperson: Responds to new membership inquires received via e-mail, phone call, No Baloney flyer, or through other promotions. Sends welcome packets to new IVW members. Submits newsletter article to newsletter editor. Attends club meetings. Plans and coordinates special events such as Poker Ride, Annual Banquet, and Bowling Party. Time requirement varies based upon desired level of involvement - typically about 2 hours per month.

Ride Chairman: Plan, organize, and supervise the annual invitational ride. Recruit ride leaders for weekly rides as well as special weekend rides. Compile ride schedule on a monthly basis and communicate activities with board members. Attend board meetings and monthly membership meetings and participate as required. Respond to member inquiries regarding rides or other issues as required.

Newsletter Editor: Compiles articles from various sources to assemble the newsletter. Uses own computer and software to put together the newsletter, sends electronic copy to Webmaster, and delivers printed copy to printer.

# **Bike Quad Cities**

June 1-3, 2001

Friday evening we'll set up camp at Illinwek Forrest Preserve on the East bank of the Mississippi River. This is an Illinois state park on Highway 84 just a few miles south of Interstate 80 where it crosses the Mississippi River. You can't miss it – if you're in lowa, turn around. Travel time is about 1.5 hours, less than 100 miles. You'll find us on the riverbank which is one of the tent areas; pads are available close by.

On Saturday morning at 9:00 A.M. the ride will leave the campground on the trail and travel the length of the Ben Butterworth Memorial Parkway to Codova (North) and out onto the scenic Mississippi River back roads through the small riverside towns. Pack a lunch just in case restaurants cannot be found. This area is to become part of the Great Illinois Trail but currently contains some missing sections.

Sunday morning we will travel from the campground into Rock Island Arsenal (South) along the river fronts of a half dozen cities with side trips to any number of the Mississippi River islands. There are trails on the Arsenal and Civil War era buildings, cemeteries, and a museum (helmets are required on the trails). From the Arsenal we can ride over the car/train bridge into downtown Davenport and continue our ride on the River Front Trail through Davenport and out onto Credit Island, providing spring flooding doesn't close the causeway. To go all the way each day is about 55 miles all on pavement. Dinner Saturday night will be at Miss Mamie's Catfish House. This place is cheap and good, but bring your own food if you want.

If time permits on Sunday afternoon we can pack up and cross the river to Bettendorf, lowa. At Devil's Glen Park, we'll ride the Duck Creek Parkway across Bettendorf and Davenport, a round trip of 27 miles. Afterwards we will return to Peoria in the late afternoon. Come for some or all of the rides each day.

All the trails are flat and asphalt, but wider tires are usable at the camp and for some side trips onto the Mississippi River islands. Maps have been published in previous years' newsletters and i'll be carrying some around with me. Gary Hartzler has moved to Moline and has acted as co-host in previous years. This year we'll tap Gary's knowledge of the back roads for our road

riding. Gary's number is 309-762-6753. Call me if you plan to come along. Larry Paustian, 694-3947.
