swapped/stolen? :) Other exchange items included tubes, rubber ducktype bike horns, wine, bike lube, lights, etc.



From the League of Illinois Bicyclists:

In November 2001, the politics that maintain cyclists as second class citizens in Illinois are ripe for change. The state's Supreme Court sports new faces since it ruled in 1998 on Boub vs. Wayne, and state legislative districts will be redrawn in 2002. For these reasons, the Chicagoland Bicycle Federation and the League of Illinois Bicyclists have decided to forego pursuing legislation during this fall's veto session. Instead, we'll start to develop a strategy around the changing districts. We think the current court is likely to overturn Boub if presented with the right case. But we believe a legislative fix is more attainable with our resources. You can help us prepare for the battle ahead. Know somebody injured possibly by negligent street conditions and unable to collect for damages? Fill out the form at www.biketraffic.org/crash, or call and we can fax you one. Also, if you know of bike facilities that have been halted or cancelled, e-mail us at ed@bikelib.org or call 630-978-0583. And we'll work to restore bicyclists' safety in 2002.
