Bike Trail Debate Continues

The August 11th edition of the Journal Star contained letters to the editor debating the value of the proposed Rock Island bike trail extension. The argument against the trail contended that extension is not an economic stimulus, as claimed by George Burrier Jr, the author of an earlier piece that appeared in the Journal Star. The argument for the trail backs up Mr. Burrier's claim that the trail extension will enhance the quality of life for Peorians, thus justifying the funding of the extension.

With the current funding shortages both locally, and nationally, finding the funds for an extension will be difficult. This will provide even more time for people to debate the merit of bike trails.

Road Rage Motorist Found Guilty of Murdering Bicyclist

Carnell Fitzpatrick was found guilty of first-degree murder in killing Chicago bike messenger Tom McBride on April 26, 1999. Fitzpatrick reportedly ran over McBride with his truck after the two had exchanged angry remarks and gestures. Fitzpatrick fled the scene, but the license plate of his truck was found under McBride's body. Fitzpatrick now faces 20 to 60 years in prison.
