Boub still bobbing The Boub issue, SB275 did not get on the agenda of IL General Assembly during their November session. Our next opportunity starts this month. when the legislators start their spring session. On November 10, we attended a local town hall meeting sponsored by state Representative Ricca Slone, co-sponsor of Senate Bill 275 which corrects the Boub liability problem. Also attending was state Senator George Shadid. We emphasized the need to address SB275 soon. Many thanks for all the phone calls to your state legislators and especially to the phone tree recruits: Bill Clark, Coralynn Green, Brad Niemcek, Mike Pula. Larry Davis. We've planted the bulbs for a beautiful spring.

#### **Sunday Winter Ride**

Starting in November there will be a Sunday afternoon ride from Banner School (corner of Allen Road and Cedar Hill Drive). The ride is open to all riders. It may split into two groups depending on the number of riders and their levels. You should check with the ride leaders if you have questions. The ride will leave the school at 1:00. Distance will depend on the group. As the days get shorter, it would be advisable to have lights as the ride may ride close to dusk. The ride leaders for December are being lined up. <u>Saturday Show and Go</u> meets at Washington Square in Washington at 8:30am all year. Distance varies from 25-60 miles.

<u>Saturday ride from Russell's</u> Don Eberle leads this popular classic, leaving the parking lot at 8:30am. It is an all-levels ride at a casual pace, going 20-30 miles with a breakfast stop in the middle. Usually get back around noon.

#### Ride Levels

More details regarding ride levels are available on the web site. Ride leaders can be contacted for specific details about their individual rides.

Beginner/Family These rides are a casual pace averaging less than 12 miles per hour and ride as group.

**Level 1** Rides average 12-14 mph and regroups on a regular basis.

**Level 2** Rides average 13-17 mph and regroup occasionally.

<u>Level 3</u> Rides average 17 miles per hour and over. Riders may regroup periodically, but should be prepared to ride in pace lines to keep from being dropped.

**Show and Go** Rides have no leaders. The distance and speed is decided upon by the group, but governed by the ride level designated.

#### This year do Illinois!

No need to drive long mileage for bike tours in other states. Try the Grand Illinois Trail And Parks ride (GITAP). It's close to home, delightfully scenic, features good food and friendly folks, and all profits go to advancing bicycling in Illinois. Sponsored by the League of Illinois Bicyclists, with the cooperation and assistance of the Illinois Department of Natural Resources, the ride is a celebration of Illinois' unique trails and state parks.

The GITAP is set for Sunday, June 13, to Saturday, June 19, 2004. It begins this year in DeKalb, travels along the I & M and the Hennepen trails to the Quad Cities, heads north on the Great River Trail to Galena, then visits two more state parks before returning to DeKalb - all told about 450 miles.

The registration fee of \$310 (\$290 for LIB members) includes camping at state parks (a motel package is also available), breakfast and dinner every day, luggage transfer and T-shirt, door prizes, and a unique touring experience around northern Illinois.
