



We recently lost Les Siegrist, one of our longtime IVW members. While I did not know Les personally, I've heard his name come up a few times in connection with the early days of the club & starting rides that eventually became the No Baloney. I think we owe Les a debt of gratitude for his work with the club, and starting events we still enjoy to this very day!

Siegrist, 75, of Washington was pronounced dead at his residence on Friday, Dec. 2, 2011, at 9:50 p.m. He was born May 4, 1936, in Peoria to Robert A. and Evelyn Mary Linebaugh Siegrist. "Share the Road" License Plate Sign-Up Has Reached 1,500!!

Thank you to everyone who has reserved the new permanent specialty "Share the Road" license plate! On Dec. 1, we reached the 1,500 plate reservations needed to begin production of the license plates.

We would love to be able to say that new license plates will arrive in time for the holidays; but, unfortunately, government does not move that quickly. Due to a lengthy design approval and production process, we are likely still looking at five to six months until plates are on cars. Why does it take so long? While the Secretary of State's office has already reviewed the plate design, officials will have to review the production sample as well. We do not expect there to be an issue; but, the review will take some time. Once the sample is approved, the state will begin producing the plates.

People who have already reserved plates will be contacted by the Secretary of State's office when the producing process is close to being completed, likely in about five months from now. Everyone who has submitted a reservation form will be notified by the Secretary of State on finishing your specialty plate order. The state will either send out a form to be completed and mailed back or will direct people to finish the process online (which is still being determined by the Secretary of State's office).

There will be an additional fee of \$34 for the switch over fee and the state's share of the first year's fee. Each year afterwards, the Secretary of State will send a renewal form that will have a fee for \$22 above the cost of standard plates. The majority of the additional fee, \$20, goes to the new Share the Road fund for LIB's bicyclist and motorist education efforts.

Those interested in receiving a personalized or vanity plate, will be able to request it on the form the Secretary of State's office will send. There would be an additional fee in addition to the specialty plate switch over fee. In about five months, the Secretary of State's office will also add the "Share the Road" design as an option to the specialty plates section of its website. At that point, people can order the plate simply by going online. Until then, people who have not yet reserved a plate but are interested in ordering one, can still fill out the reservation form and mail the form and a check for \$17 to LIB, 2550 Cheshire Dr., Aurora, IL 60504.

We will be updating our Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) page as soon as we receive some more details from the Secretary of State's office. Additionally, we will send out a postcard to everyone who sent their reservation forms in to LIB. We are also looking into a license plate frame that will not cover up the "Share the Road" license plate's design and will post information as soon as it is available.


