



Membership Renewal Process Change By Mike Honnold

A new change may be coming to the IVW for 2013 in the way you renew your membership each year. For as long as I can remember (and as long as anybody else can remember), your IVW renewal date for membership has floated during the year depending when you sent in the form and payment. While this system minimizes the amount of mail we receive on a monthly basis, our database administrator is burdened 12 months out of the year processing the monthly submissions. If the majority of our membership paperwork could be processed in one month at the beginning of the year, the services of our coordinator might be driven toward other projects.

Plans are still being brainstormed/developed, but our thoughts are to switch the yearly membership over to a January 1st renewal date. We feel this date will be very easy for people to remember, and should result in fewer members accidentally dropping off the membership roster. As far as new members are concerned, if they join before June 30th, they would pay for a full-price membership, and pay half price for joining after June 30th. Of course, new member renewal dates would also default back to January 1st once the New Year rolled around to keep everyone on the same schedule.

Because the membership renewal cycle is documented in our IVW constitution, we will be required to place the "official" new plan in writing (newsletter & website) for 60 days before voting on it at one of the future IVW board meetings. All IVW members present at this meeting will be allowed to vote on the matter with majority rule.

Please keep posted to future IVW newsletters regarding the progress of this improvement. We hope to implement a plan by mid-year so any current members who have paid (or will pay) their 2012/2013 dues can be done so in a pro-rated manner reflective of the new January 1st, 2013 date.

Below are a few of the other benefits we've noted ->

- 1. Less information we'll need to include with every monthly newsletter (renewing members, renewal dates, past-due renewals), which should allow us more space in the newsletter for articles, reviews, club info, etc...
- 2. Fewer reports the database coordinator will need to make each month so we can remind members of when their renewal dates are.
- **3.** Fewer e-mails from myself or the database coordinator reminding members their memberships are due.
- **4.** Less chance for a member to accidentally slip off the membership roster and miss the monthly newsletter / e-mail updates.
- 5. A better reason to go to bed early on New Year's Eve so you can wake up early on New Year's Day and send in your membership form (sorry no prizes will be awarded for the first renewing member each year).
- 6. Possible higher & longer retention levels of club members.

At our January board meeting, the IVW board voted to donate an additional \$3,300 dollars of our profit from 2011 to Lakeview Museum (prior commitment), and Peoria Park District's plans to replace their aging fleet of bicycles at Safety Town. We are needing to save back some of the profit for planned increases in our insurance costs due to rising participation numbers from No Baloney and Ride of Silence. While the increased ride attendance is a great thing to experience, it also brings additional financial burden on the club to keep everybody safe and protected – from a physical and legal standpoint. 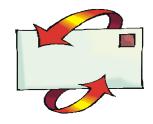
