# IVW president & volunteer coordinator positions left open for 2013 term

#### Basic/suggested presidential responsibilities

- 1. Develop agenda for monthly board meetings & request input for agenda from other board members and/or IVW club members
- 2. Act as main contact person for club, and respond in a timely manner to all reasonable requests coming from inside and outside the club. These requests can come in the form of email, phone calls, letters, or personal requests. Some requests may be better answered by other IVW board members, or other cyclists within the community.
- 3. There are few speaking engagements required by the club president (I've done two), but should a speaking engagement present itself, the club president would be the first likely option. If the club president is not comfortable with doing this, it would be their responsibility to find another appropriate speaker, or decline the request.
- 4. Keep eyes/ears open to cycling/advocacy opportunities within the community that might be a good thing for the IVW to become involved in.
- 5. Do your best to fill any vacant IVW board member spots that should come up throughout the year and/or act as the vacant spot until another person is found.
- 6. Make yourself available for any IVW volunteering opportunities that might come up during the year, and help out when possible.
- 7. Not 100% required but good if the acting president can contribute some sort of an article to the monthly newsletter on a semi-regular basis
- 8. Develop agenda for and act as MC at year-end IVW meeting in November.


