

Ride Leader Training Course

On Saturday, April 6th, 2013, the Illinois Valley Wheelm'n will be sponsoring a ride leader training course taught by Quad Cities Bicycle Club certified cycling instructor, Donnie Miller. Donnie offers a well-rounded class for attendees focusing on subjects from planning a route to basic first aid support while on the road. After a morning of classroom instruction, Donnie finishes up his instruction by taking participants out on the road so they can put their newly-learned skills to practical use.

The Illinois Valley Wheelm'n will be offering this class free of charge to all our current weekly club ride leaders from the 2012 season, and any current club member who shows interest in becoming one of our ride leaders. Our hope is to start off 2013 right by promoting a new level of bicycling safety, advocacy, and knowledge within the ranks of our ride leaders.

Training will be held from 9 AM to 1:30 PM on April 6th at the St. Francis Anglican Church in Lake of the Woods Plaza; Dunlap (12200 North Brentfield Drive) – near the Cedar Hills/ Knoxville intersection. Illinois Bicycle and Pedestrian Consideration Act

In July 2007 the Illinois General Assembly enacted Public Act 095-0665. This landmark act mandates that bicycle and pedestrian traffic must be considered in the planning and development of new road projects as well as improvements to existing roads. The IVW have already received several requests this year from the Illinois Department of Transportation for our feedback on proposed improvements to some of the roads in the Central Illinois area that are well-traveled by cyclists. The club has taken every opportunity we have to provide the state with valuable feedback that could dramatically improve the road conditions for our riders and future generations. I applaud the state's proactive efforts in utilizing local clubs to generate the most feedback possible in the hopes of making Illinois a bike-friendly state!
