

IVW Privacy Policy

Recently I have received reports of suspicious emails being sent to IVW members. These emails give the appearance that the sender had been in contact with the club and possibly received member email address from club leadership. Some of these emails even have suspicious links attached to the bottom. **Please do not click on these links**. These emails are spam and some may be simple and crude attempts to fraudulently obtain personal information. I want to clarify the IVW's position on member email addresses so everyone is aware of our operations. **We do not sell or distribute member email addresses, membership lists, or other personal information to anyone under any circumstances**.

Your membership information is stored in an offline database curated by our Database Manager. To enable club operations the list of member email addresses and contact information is circulated monthly by the Database Manager to a select group of board members on a "need to know" basis - the President, Vice President, Volunteer Coordinator, Newsletter Editor and Mailer, No Baloney Coordinator, and Social Coordinator. That is the extent of our usage and handling of member information. The only exception is that ride leader contact information may be given to new or prospective members who inquire about joining weekly rides. In these cases the information given is no more than what is listed in the newsletter for a particular ride leader.

Official club communications only come from email addresses of board members (listed on the website and in the newsletter) or the general club email addresses (ivwheelmn@gmail.com, ivwn-obaloney@gmail.com, or NoBaloneyBicycleRide@gmail.com). We utilize the "Blind Carbon Copy" (bcc) feature of emails to ensure that recipients are unable to see the full list of email addresses. Emails from any other sender are not official club communications and should be regarded with suspicion. If you receive a questionable email please forward it to me as soon as possible so we can verify its authenticity and report it if necessary.

For the sake of transparency we will be updating our club bylaws with the member information privacy and usage policies in the near future. If you have observed a violation of this policy or have any questions or concerns please do not hesitate to contact me.

- Fold 20-25 member copies and place into envelopes
- Utilize current IVW database to print labels from the current version OR if you do not have the necessary computer skills, you can also hand-address them
- Take mailed copies to post office
- Place 10-15 newsletter copies into manila folders for (4) local bike shops, and either drop them off in person AND/OR mail through the post office.

Communicate with local bike shops and IVW board to regulate the number of copies being distributed to shops if they need more/fewer.
