The combined mileage of all the participants totaled to 57,179.5 miles, 11,903.5 miles more than last year. That is equivalent to around 170 round-trips from downtown Peoria to downtown Chicago, or almost 23 round-trips from Minneapolis, Minnesota to New Orleans, Louisiana, or almost 9 round-trips from east coast(Bangor, Maine) to west coast(San Francisco, California), or going around the earth at the equator 2.3 times.
